CURRENT ISSUES

Valuers, Appraisers and Estate Agents Act 1981/ Strata Titles Act 1985/ Building and Common Property (Maintenance and Management) Act 2007

The saga continues Together with other like-minded associations and organisations in the Joint Action Group (JAG), PPK continues to lobby relevant authorities for the right of all qualified practitioners, regardless of professions or otherwise, to perform property management for all categories of buildings.

To present our case, a meeting was held recently on 19 January 2009 to update and brief officials from the Ministry of Housing and Local Government, including the Minister himself, YB Dato' Seri Ong Ka Chuan.

Following this, the JAG decided to form the Property Management Council of Malaysia (PMCM) in order to unite the participating organizations as a formal body.

Guidelines for Foreign Participation in the Distributive Trades

A meeting was convened by the Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs (MDTCA) on 25 February 2009 wherein we were informed of more proposed stringent regulations affecting hypermarkets and supermarkets directly. As these may have eventual undesirable repercussions on shopping centre operations, PPK Malaysia is currently seeking clarifications from MDTCA.

No Smoking Regulations

"Every breath you take ..." is becoming even more important ...firstly, give up smoking and secondly, don't be a victim of second-hand smoking! This is the message from the Ministry of Health (MOH) who clarified that no smoking is applicable to all 'covered' areas in shopping centres, regardless of whether these were air-conditioned or otherwise. Whilst the onus is on shopping centres to advise patrons by appropriate signages, enforcement is the responsibility of MOH.
